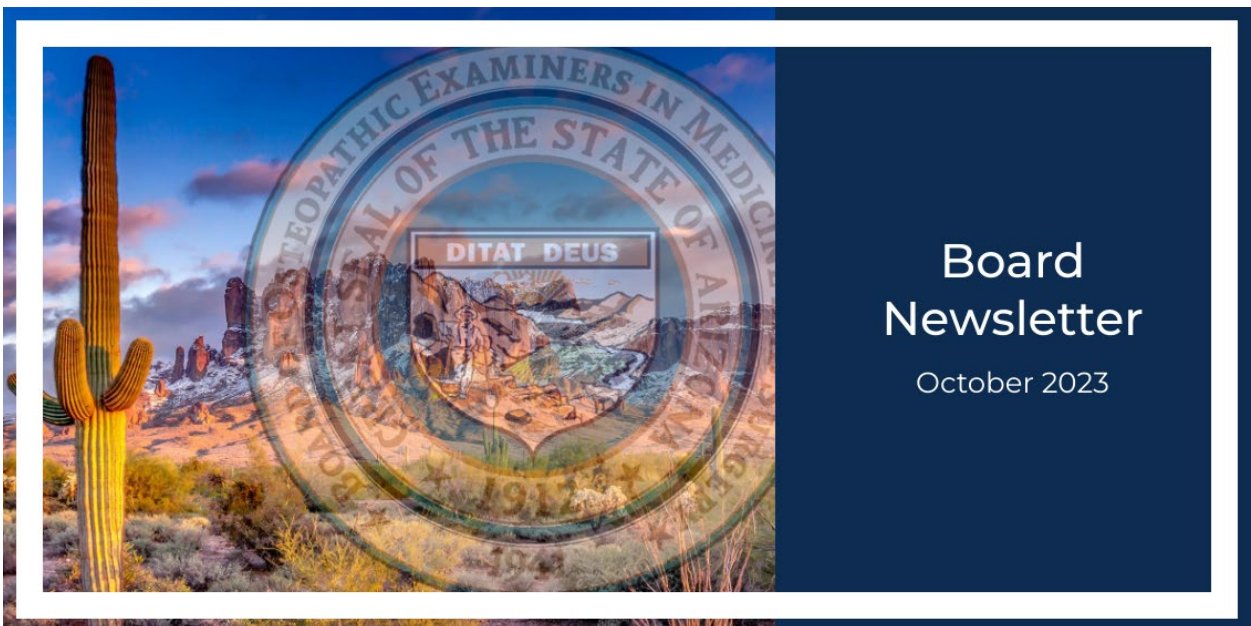

Continuing Medical Education

You can now add your CME credits to your profile any time of year. Login to the portal and click Continuing Education and enter your CME information. You can even upload your certificate with the entered information, then when it comes to renewals you won't have to search and find your certificates again. You are required to have at least 24 hours of AOA 1-A CME to meet your 40 hour CME requirement for each renewal cycle. *Did you know that the Osteopathic Board has required AOA CME for the renewal of licensure since before 1950?*

It is the fall season, and if you were issued a license in an odd numbered calendar year, its time to renew your license. 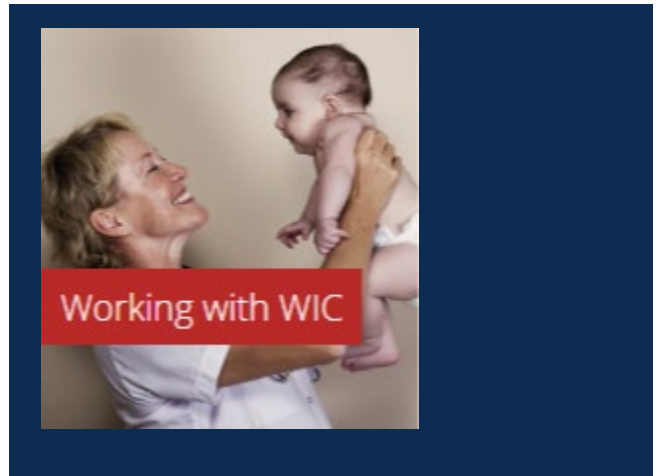


WIC Update

In 2022 the [IMLC](#) added 8 member boards as participants. As of July 6, 2023, Hawaii and Missouri have passed and their respective Governors have signed the legislation required to begin onboarding to the compact.
