Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2), The Board may vote to go into Executive Session to discuss records exempt by law from public inspection. Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03 (A) (3), the Board may vote to go into Executive Session to obtain legal advice on any item on the agenda. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(4), The Board may vote to go into Executive Session to discuss, consider its position and instruct its attorneys in pending or contemplated litigation or in settlement discussions conducted in order to avoid or resolve litigation.
